

SPRING 2024 REGISTRATION:

Spring 2024 Registration

Session 1 and 3-credit classes	November 20 to December 22			
Late Registration (Session 1 and 3-credit classes)	December 23 to December 29			
Session 2 classes	January 23 to February 26			

Registration for Spring Semester 2024 Session 1, 2-credit and 3-credit classes will take place November 20 through December 22. That may sound like a long time, but we encourage you to register early and buy your textbooks to avoid late fees and not having your textbooks by the time classes start. Late registration closes on December 29 and Spring Semester classes begin on January 9, 2024. Session 2 registration opens on January 23.

Register early! And remember to purchase your textbooks so you'll have them when classes start on January 10.



As a reminder, you can DROP a class without penalty during Week 1 of the class. After the first week, there are financial and/or transcript penalties for deferring or withdrawing from a class. Should you need to leave a class part way through the semester, your options depend on how far into the class you are.

During Weeks 2-4, you can DEFER your class, meaning that you will be charged a \$50 deferral fee, but your tuition and fees for the class will be credited to your account and you will not see the class appear on your transcript for that semester.

If you wait until Week 5 to leave a class, you can petition for an INCOMPLETE or WITHDRAW from the class. In order to petition for an Incomplete, a student must have completed at least 75 percent of their work for the class and demonstrate a hardship that prevents the completion of the class on time.

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Instructors will review petitions on a case-by-case basis. If granted, the student receives a new date to complete the remaining portion of his or her class work.

If you are not eligible for an Incomplete, or your petition is denied, you can Withdraw from the class, receive a "W" on your transcript and re-take the class in a future semester, forfeiting your tuition and fees for the class.

This chart shows these important dates for Spring Semester 2024. As you can see, the dates for each period depend on when the class begins. It is important to be mindful of these dates as you begin your courses. Should you need to drop, defer or withdraw from a course, contact the Registrar immediately for assistance so that you don't miss an important timeline.



Spring Semester 2024 begins on January 9 and runs through May 6. Our Spring Break Week is scheduled for March 5 through March 13 and Session 2 will begin on March 12.

MTC-B MINISTERIAL INTENSIVE UPDATE

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MTC-B Students - plan ahead for 2024!

- MINS 2650: *The Aquarian-Age Minister* will be held March 5-8, 2024, at the Inner Retreat in Corwin Springs, Montana.
- Prerequisites: MINS 2110, PSYS 2201, MINS 2610, MINS 2780, MINS 2770, and MINS 3280.

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MTC-B ministerial studies students are encouraged to plan ahead to attend the **MTC-B Intensive: The Aquarian-Age Minister** which will be offered March 5-8, 2024 at the Inner Retreat in Corwin Springs, Montana.

Prerequisites include Homiletics 2, Pastoral Care, CUT Sacraments and Holy Orders, Spiritual Psychology 2, The Holy Spirit: Fire from Heaven, and A Spiritual Perspective on the Issues of Our Time. Students may be enrolled in a prerequisite during spring semester 2024 to attend (not including MINS 2110 or MINS 2780). MINS 2110 Homiletics 2 and MINS 2780 CUT Sacraments and Holy Orders must be completed prior to attending the intensive. Attendance at the MINS 2650 ministerial intensive is required to graduate from the MTC-B program. Further details and information will be sent to the MTC-B students.

Are you interested in learning how to write for social media to share the teachings of the ascended masters? SU is offering ENGL 1275 Writing for Social Media during Spring Semester 2024. This onecredit session 1 course will be held January 9 to March 4. Students will learn social media navigation and how to create quality platform-specific content to engage readers with the teachings of the ascended masters on social media.

This course includes detailed exercises to help students get comfortable with writing for the web. This is a great course for people who are new to social media, or those looking to hone their social media writing skills.
