Video script text (7-21-16)

To play a video clip, click on the **play button in the bottom left corner of the video**. Use the **volume control** to adjust the video's volume. **You can also adjust the volume by using your computer's built-in volume control, or the volume control on your speakers.** To make the video full-screen, click the **full-screen button**. To return to the normal video size, click the return button. **If the video controls disappear, hover your mouse over the video and they will appear.**

Occasionally, you may encounter an "Audio with Slides" video in your course. This type of video is actually an audio clip with one or more slides. To listen to the audio clip, simply click the play button. The slides will change automatically as you listen to the clip. Keep in mind that some of these clips only have one or two slides associated with them.

Depending on your download speed, you can usually start playing a video when the picture appears in the video window. However, **if the video is choppy and stopping to buffer, then we recommend that you click the pause button to allow the video to stream to your computer first before watching it.** Hover your mouse over the video box to see how much of the video has streamed to your computer. When the grey bar reaches the right hand side of the bar, the entire video has streamed to your computer. You can often start playing the video when about half of it has streamed, as it will continue streaming while you watch.

Video Player Key Features

The following image shows an example of a video player with key features labeled. Explanations of these labels are below the image.



1. **Play/Pause Button:** Push to play; this button will change to a pause button. To pause, click the button again.

2. **Progress Bar:** As the clip plays, the progress bar will change from grey to light blue-violet.
3. **Volume Control:** Click on the bars to lower or raise the volume; five small color bars (as shown above) denote the loudest video volume. You can also adjust the volume on your computer and/or external speakers.
4. **Full-Screen Button:** Click this button to enter full-screen mode. Click it again to return to regular mode.
